


Morris Glenn Dodd, Sr., age 89, resident of Oakland, Tennessee, entered the presence of the Lord on April 22, 2024.

Glenn was born October 28, 1934 in Trimble, Tennessee, at his mother's family home. His parents were the late Glenn Strachn Dodd and Gertrude Glasgow Dodd. He served his country in the United States Navy Reserves.

The last several years of his career he worked for City Leasing and then retired from Sears-Roebuck and Company after a few short years working in sales. Glenn was married January 19, 1979 to Elizabeth Dodd and had been a resident of Oakland since 1999. He was a member of Hickory Withe Baptist Church in Eads, Tennessee and was a storyteller who enjoyed fishing, golfing and gardening.
