## Process Work Institute

It is one of many centers worldwide dedicated to furthering our understanding of the fundamental problems facing individuals and groups today, using the methods and spirit of inquiry found in Processwork.

## Accreditation

The Process Work Institute is accredited by the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools to award the Master's Degree in Process-Oriented Facilitation and Conflict Studies and the Postgraduate Certificate in Advanced Process-Oriented Facilitation (Advanced Certificate).

## Definition of a unit of credit

A quarter credit is defined as, at a minimum, 10 classroom "clock (contact) hours" of academic engagement (direct instruction) or 30 hours of externship. The successful award of a quarter credit unit includes the expectation of two hours of out-of-class student preparation for every hour of direct instruction. A quarter term is defined as 10 weeks.

## Program Credit Requirements

Completion of the Master in Process-Oriented Facilitation and Conflict Studies requires 57 credit hours. Completion of the Postgraduate Certificate in Advanced Process-Oriented Facilitation (Advanced Certificate) requires 57.5 credit hours.

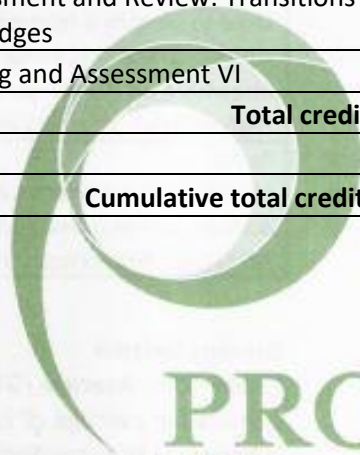

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
