Bonnie Isaacson, 75, of Underwood, died Monday, June 12, 2023, in her home.

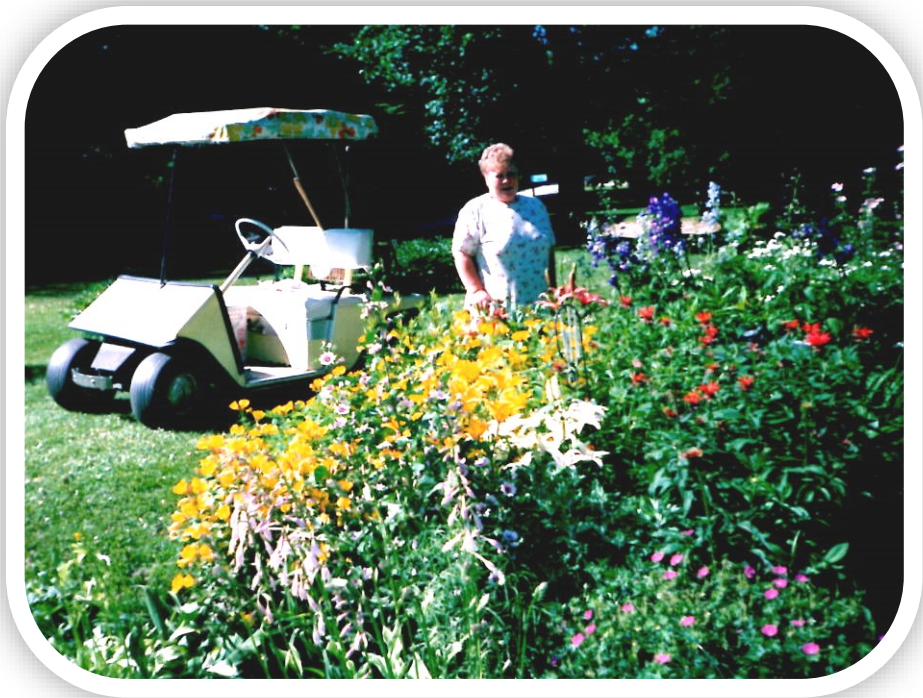
