The **Walla Walla University Basketball tournament** is a well-organized event. We are one of fourteen other schools that are participating. Yesterday, the event began with an orientation meeting for all participants which provided expectations for behavior and sportsmanship along with other procedural instructions. 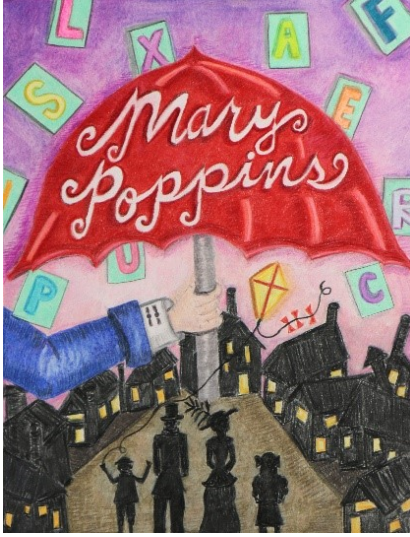

High School Non-Academic School Day

February 6, 2020

Our high school calendar allows for the following four non-academic school days. These are counted as part of our 180 days of school, where attendance is taken:

- November 9th – Fall Food Festival
- January 23rd - Winter Sport's Day
- February 6th - Winter Sport's Day
- May 28th – Spring Fling

On Thursday, February 6th our high school students will have the following choices to choose from. Please check the option that best suits your child:

- Go to North Star for one of our annual snow sports days – The cost of this trip is \$92 with forms and dollars due to the office by Monday, January 28th.
- A snowshoe hike – The cost for this option would be \$15, which would include rental of snowshoes. Students should be dressed for cold weather and have their own snow boots. This group would be limited to 14 students.
- Students that are main characters with speaking parts, would be welcome to come to school to work with Mrs. Genobaga on their lines for Mary Poppins.
- Community service opportunity. We know of an elderly person that could use help with some yard work. Group size limited to 7 students.
- Spend four hours shadowing a career that the student is interested in obtaining more information. Student would be responsible for setting up this shadowing experience and filling out the required evaluation form. This option would help meet part of the job shadowing requirements needed for graduation.
