



Mothers Never Really Die

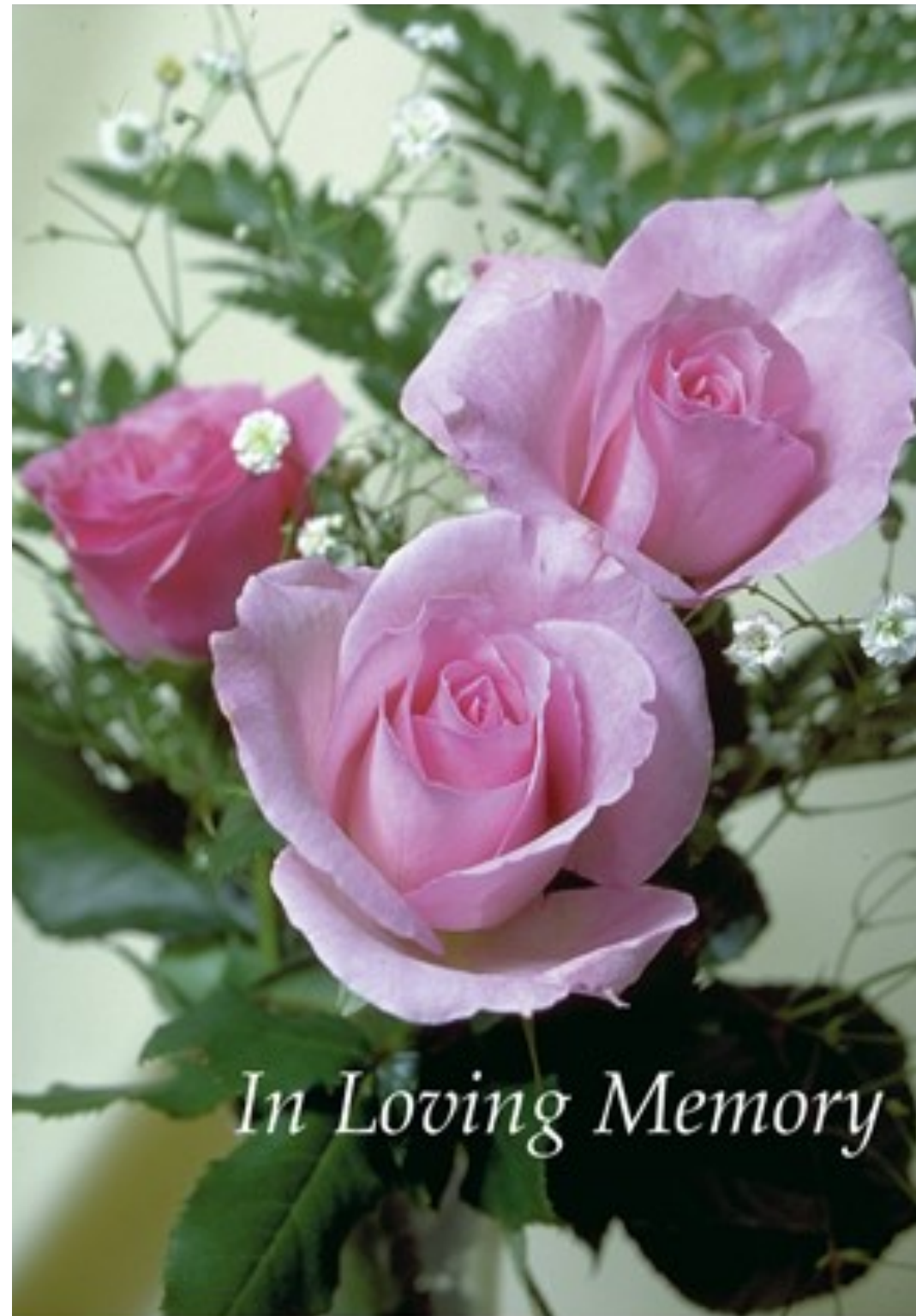
Death beckoned her with outstretched hand
