Seeking God in His Word

“He awakens me morning by morning, He awakens my ear to hear as the learned. The Lord has opened my ears.” Isaiah 50:4

Ask - God to be present before your devotion time. Invite Him to speak to you through His Word by bringing to your attention something He wants you to understand, learn or practice.

Read - selected section of Scripture deliberately. Take note of the words and phrases that catch your attention and/or intrigue you. Read them a second time (or more).

Reflect - on what grabs your attention. What connections are there with our life? How might God be speaking to you through these words? Stop long enough to let this take root. Thank God for speaking to your heart.

Respond - to the Scripture. Talk to God in prayer about what’s on your mind and heart. Look for ways to live out what you’ve experienced in your devotional time. And look for ways to tell others about what you’ve discovered.

Memorizing His Word

Mar. 30 *“But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.” Hebrews 2: 9*
