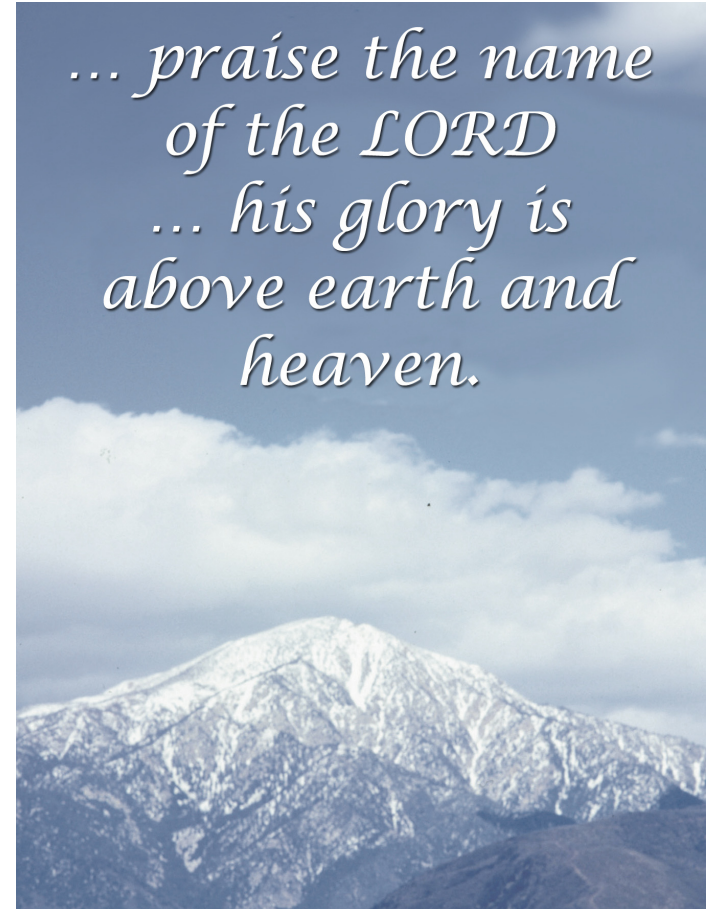
OUR CHURCH

CAA News. Annual constituency session (open to the public) is scheduled for Thursday, April 26, 7:00 p.m. in the academy Chapel/Cafeteria.

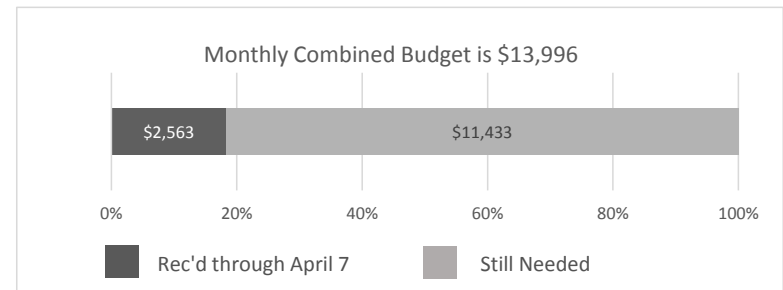
