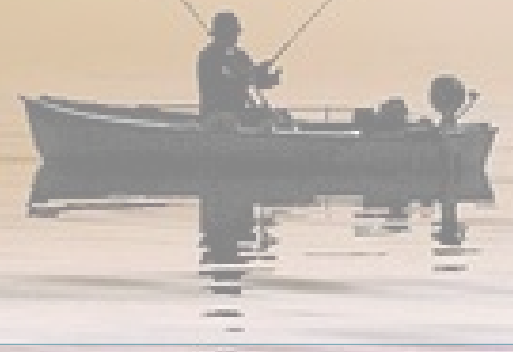
He is preceded in death by his son Ian and followed in death by his sister Michele Seifert.

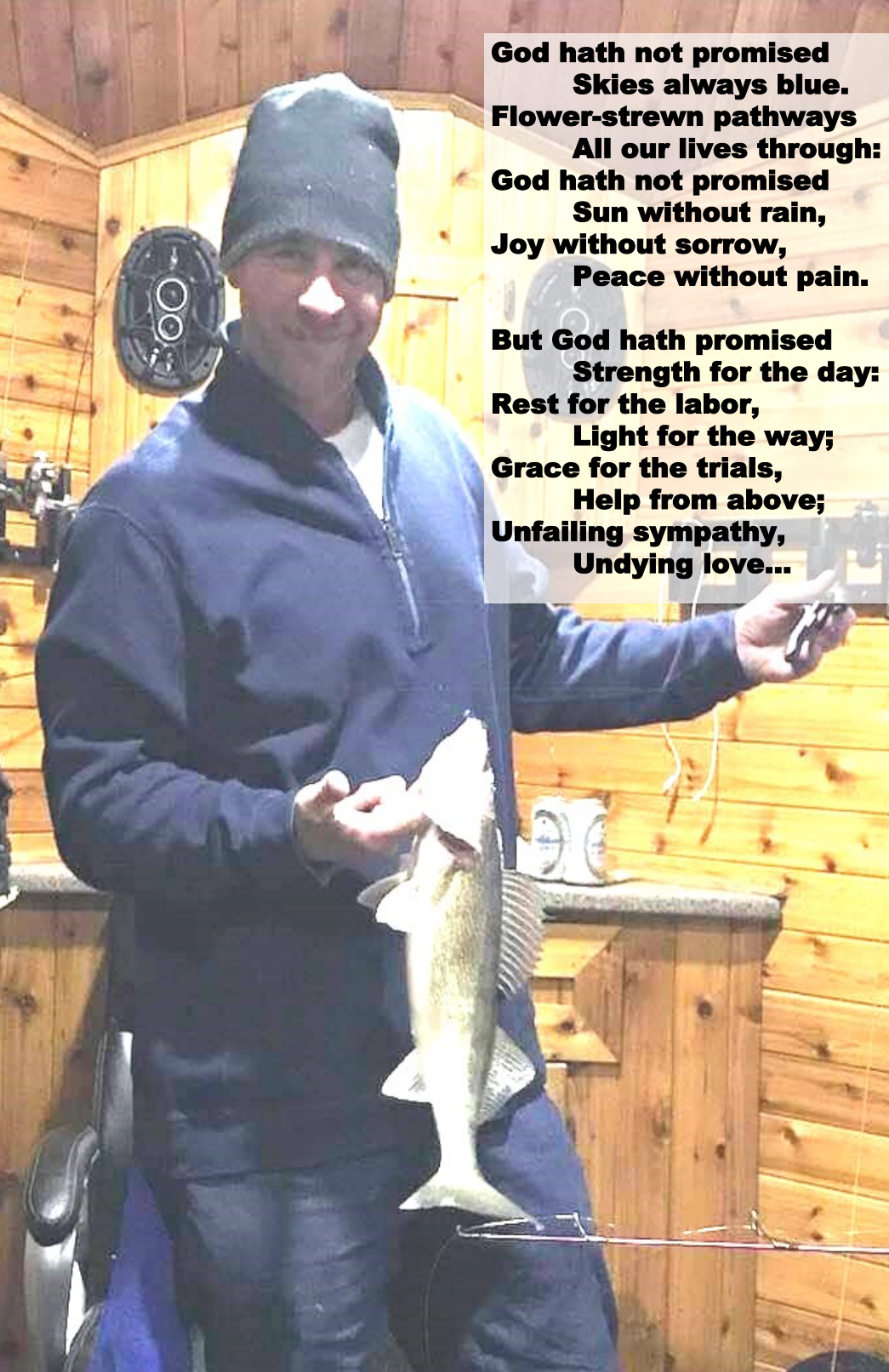
