Romans Reading Plan

Day 1 (Apr. 27)

Reading: Romans 1

Major Moment: Paul exalts the gospel, explains the sinfulness of mankind and teaches how God has revealed Himself through His Creation.

Day 2 (Apr. 28)

Reading: Romans 2

Major Moment: The danger of judging others and God's righteous judgment towards us

Day 3 (Apr. 29)

Reading: Romans 3

Major Moment: Paul teaches that the law will not make us righteous. Righteousness comes through faith in Jesus Christ alone.

Day 4 (Apr. 30)

Reading: Romans 4

Major Moment: Abraham is justified through faith.

Day 5 (May. 1)

Reading: Romans 5

Major Moment: Paul explains death through Adam and life through Christ.

Day 6 (May. 4)

Reading: Romans 6

Major Moment: As believers, we are not slaves to sin, but slaves to righteousness.

Day 7 (May. 5)

Reading: Romans 7

Major Moment: Release from the Law in Christ and the battle between the flesh and the spirit

Day 8 (May. 6)

Reading: Romans 8

Major Moment: The saving work of Christ gives us new life in the Spirit.

Day 9 (May. 7)

Reading: Romans 9

Major Moment: Paul grieves over Israel's unbelief and teaches about God's sovereign election.

Day 10 (May. 8)

Reading: Romans 10

Major Moment: Salvation comes from hearing, believing and confessing that Jesus is Lord.

Day 11 (May. 11)

Reading: Romans 11

Major Moment: Paul assures the Jewish people that God has not forgotten them. He teaches that God's mercy is for everyone.

Day 12 (May. 12)

Reading: Romans 12

Major Moment: Guidelines for living as redeemed people in a fallen world

Day 13 (May. 13)

Reading: Romans 13

Major Moment: Paul instructs the people to submit to the governing authorities.

Day 14 (May. 14)

Reading: Romans 14

Major Moment: Instruction on dealing with those of weak and strong faith

Day 15 (May. 15)

Reading: Romans 15

Major Moment: Paul's ministry to the Gentiles and the Gentile's ministry to the Jews

Day 16 (May. 18)

Reading: Romans 16

Major Moment: Final instructions from Paul to the believers in Rome
