

May 15th, 2017 CSCA Board Meeting

Board attendees: Seth Hertlein, Yvette Quintela, Jack Orrick, Julie Weber, Rob Gorman, Bill Draper. Excused: Stefan LoBuglio, Bill Moore, and Cindy Udell

Jack introduced the board to attendees followed by attendee introductions.

Minutes from the April meeting were unanimously approved. Jack then recapped the Fenway Rd traffic calming project. It was noted that there are still outstanding questions about speed boards and whether they are an option or not. Jack recommended we continue to review the option and there was no further information to discuss at this time with respect to speed boards.

It was noted that the survey data shows, when looking block-by-block, a divergence of opinion based upon where people live. There is mixed support at both ends of Fenway road while the 8200-8500 address block shows strong support. Jack opened the question to the traffic committee whether to go forward with trial islands. A vote was taken of the board and it was decided to conduct another survey, focusing solely on support of trial islands.

Further discussion was had about sidewalks as an option and it was noted that they are almost certainly not a viable option due to cost and disruption of property.

The topic of beltway sound barriers was raised and Seth had nothing to add at this time.

The house tour was discussed and due to low availability of recent renovations and some still being completed it was decided to revisit it in the Fall, roughly October.

The topic of the Quiet Skies initiative was brought up with nothing further to add at this time.

The newsletter deadline was recommended for the first week in June with the trial island survey to coincide. Jack recommended a 4 week survey open period to give people plenty of time to respond given summer travels beginning.

The meeting was adjourned.
