George Clifford Gimmestad was born on February 22, 1927, in Belview, MN, to Arthur and Ernestina (Dehnel) Gimmestad. The family moved to the Odessa/Bellingham, MN, area where he attended school and graduated high school with the Class of 1945.

In July of 1945, George was inducted into the United States Army at Fort Snelling in Minneapolis, MN. He served with the 674<sup>th</sup> Parachute Field Artillery Battalion during World War II. George was honorably discharged at Fort Lewis, WA, on December 18, 1946.

On February 20, 1955, George was united in marriage with Maryanne Hanson in Ortonville, MN. To this union, three children were born.

George worked as an interior and exterior decorator and worked in many homes in the Ortonville area putting in flooring or painting. He was an active member of the United Congregational Church of Christ and served on the Church Board.
