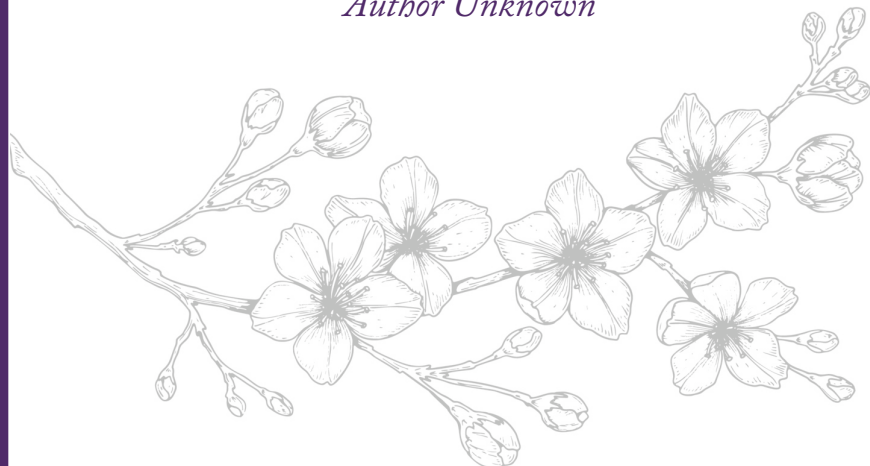




Family Tree
