

Osceola Adventist Christian School UNIFORM CODE

All Osceola Adventist Christian School students are required to wear school approved uniforms. No exceptions to the uniform policy will be permitted.

It is our goal to make the school uniform policy financially affordable to parents.

1. Shirts: Shirts must be a hunter green or red polo with a collar, and the appropriate size for the child. Shirts must be tucked into bottoms. **NO VESTS OR ANY CLOTHING ARE ALLOWED OVER POLO SHIRTS.**

2. Bottoms: Pants, shorts, skirts and jumpers are to be tan or navy blue, and must be the appropriate size for the child. No baggy pants or "slim-fitting" pants are to be worn. Pants shall be worn so that the waistband is worn at the waist. A fitting belt must be worn with pants and undergarments **MAY NOT** show.

3. Shorts, skorts, jumpers, scooters, shirts and dresses: The hem of these items shall extend to the tip of the fingertips when both arms are extended by the side. Tights or leggings of solid khaki, white, navy or black color may be worn under skirts and skorts so long as the skirt or shorts meets the length requirement.

4. Shoes: All students shall wear shoes/footwear that are closed toe to protect the entire foot.

5. Jewelry: No jewelry of any type, including wristbands, hair bands around the wrist, or any item that may be construed as jewelry, may be worn (exception is a wedding band worn by faculty/staff members).

6. Outerwear: Coats, jackets and sweaters shall be plain green, red or white colored and appropriately sized for the student and shall be worn only when the weather conditions dictate. Long overcoats that might serve to conceal contraband shall be removed immediately upon arrival at the school or school function. Sweaters/Hoodies shall be removed upon entering the school building.

7. Headgear: The following is not allowed at Osceola Adventist Christian School: hats, caps, bandanas, scarves, towels, stocking caps, sweatbands, doo rags, headphones, and ear buds.

8. Hair and Makeup: Hair may not be cut, colored or worn in such a manner or extreme fashion that it is distracting or disruptive to the learning environment. Makeup, including fingernail polish, should not be worn at the elementary level (PK-8).

9. Emblems and Logos: Emblems and logos, including those depicting skulls, peace signs, and occult themes, may not be worn on any clothing item and may not be on student book bags (backpacks) or any item brought by the student to school.

10. P.E. Uniforms: No P.E. uniform is required.

If you are not sure, do not wear it. Students who are out of compliance with the dress code policy will be asked to return home and return with the appropriate dress code items. Students will not be given an excused tardy or absence, should they not return to school, for being out of compliance with the uniform policy. Parents will be expected to comply with this policy.
