The team of horses were tired and so was grandpa, so Marlys's uncle got a fresh team of Stanley's horses and left on the cemetery road, picked up Dr. Shelver, and returned to Stanley's to exchange the horses and they continued on to the farm. When they returned to the farm, and Marlys's aunt and grandma were there to help deliver Marlys. Dr. Shelver spent the night at the farm during the storm and left the next morning.

Marlys attended school for eight years at good ole' District 9 which was also the township hall, so they had a holiday every time there was an election. She attended high school in Ortonville and graduated with the Class of 1944.
