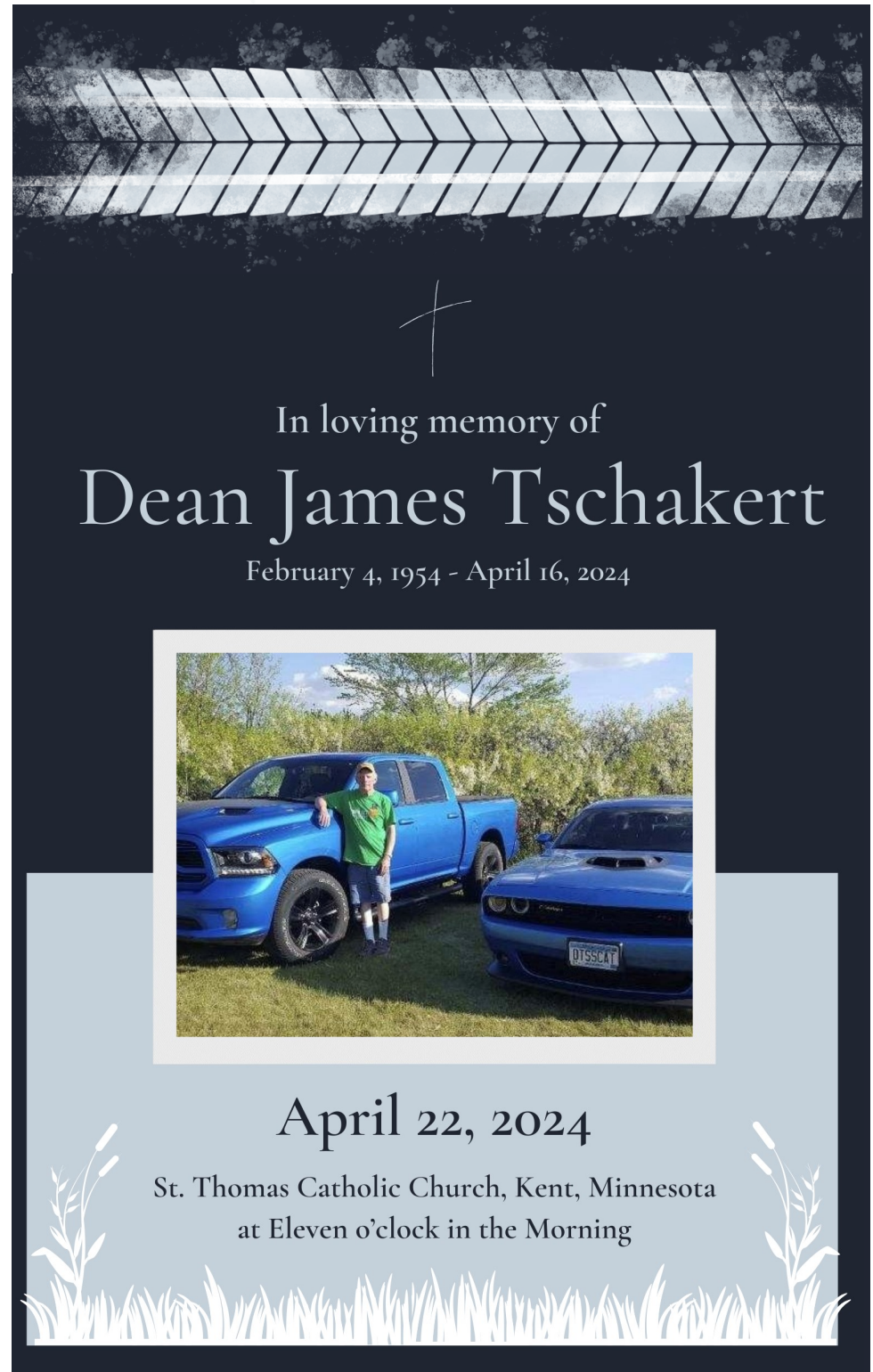


# Fast Car
