COMMITMENT

A word which came out of an Elders meeting. It has implications for us all.

- 1. God committed His Son to be a human and to suffer a horrendous death so that we as sinners could be forgiven and set free. Today praise God for this.
- 2. Are you still excited about belonging to Jesus? Do you remember the commitment you made? Do you need to pray about recommitting your life and get back to that first love place when God really was Number 1?
- 3. Remember God has committed Himself to us and promised never to leave us, or forsake us. Talk to Him about this.
- 4. This commitment of God to us and us to God, is not a one off thing. We haven't "arrived" and therefore need to do nothing more. We need to daily take up our cross, ask daily to be filled with His Spirit and do what He wants. Pray about this, ponder on its implications.
- 5. We are told to devote ourselves to one another, sharing and caring for each other. What does this imply?
- 6. There are a number of people who undertake a huge commitment to work in the Fellowship. This can take a toll on their lives and families. Is there more I can do to ease their burden? Is there something I could do; teach in Kids Church, Youth Church, help in the Hub, Coffee Shop or anything else?
- 7. The Leadership feel God is saying expand the work. One way we feel this may happen is to run two Sunday Fishes instead of one. This needs extra people too. There are implications for the Fellowship in DBC as well.
 - How committed are we to working with God in expanding the Kingdom? Pray through this.
