## *The Pastor's Blog*

“Is this not the fast that I have chosen: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? *Is it* not to share your bread with the hungry, and that you bring to your house the poor who are cast out; when you see the naked, that you cover him, and not hide yourself from your own flesh? Then your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the LORD shall be your rear guard. Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer; you shall cry, and He will say, ‘Here I *am*.’” (Isaiah 58:6-9)

We need to be kind to one another. As a rule of thumb, be as good to others as God has been to you. Do not ignore people who need help. Be the helping hand you wished someone gave you during your time of need. Fulfill the mission of the kingdom in the way that you speak to others (even those in your immediate family) then watch and see how the Lord rewards you!

Additionally, God expects us to forgive one another and to do rightly by one another on a daily basis. We all make mistakes, we’ve all said something that we should not have, yet God’s expectation is that we make amends. Ask people you’ve offended for forgiveness and apologize. Even if they have partial blame, do not expect an apology in return. Do what God enables you to do and be the bigger person.

This week, as we continue to pray to God for our different needs and wants, I challenge you to do well by people and to make amends for wrongs you have done. You will soon experience the great difference it will make in your life and in the likelihood that the Lord will favourably answer your prayers.

“Therefore, if you bring your gift to the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.” (Matthew 5:23-24)
