She grew up on a farm near Havelock, ND, attended a one room school house for a couple of years and then Havelock Grade School. She graduated from New England High School in 1950. Eudora married Ignatius Sticka on May 17, 1954 at St Mary’s Church and raised four children in New England before moving to Bismarck in 1972. Her days were filled with time with her family, baking, gardening, bowling, reading, playing pinochle, Sudoku, and family trips to the casino. Eudora was an avid Minnesota Twins and Vikings fan. After moving to Bismarck, she worked at the Register of Deeds Office for four years and the State Health Department for 10 years. In her final year, she lived in Yorkshire at Touchmark, enjoying many activities, especially music, which she loved! Eudora and Ig were privileged to celebrate their 70th wedding anniversary this past May with their family and friends.
