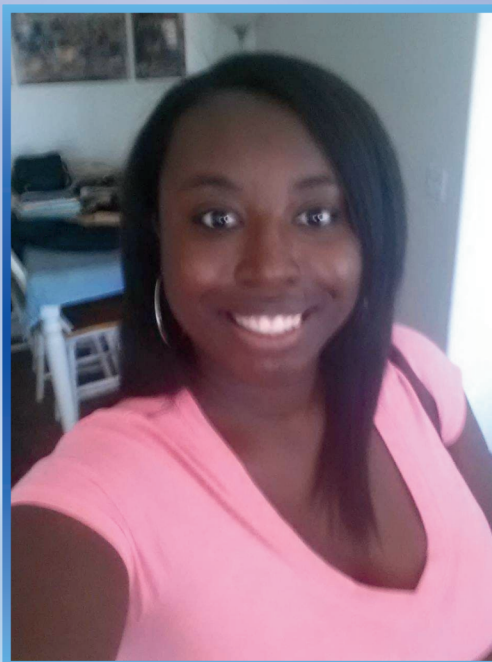
LIFE & LEGACY OF

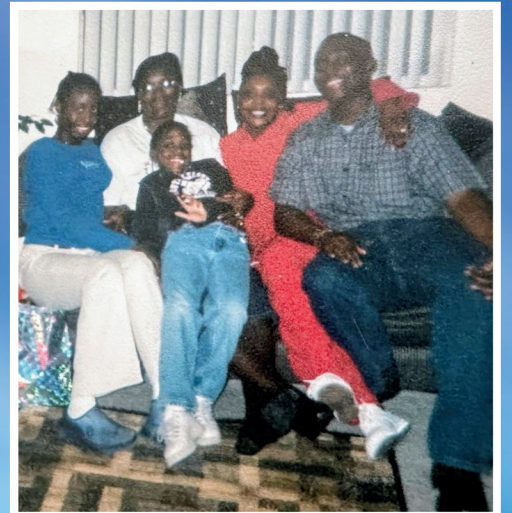
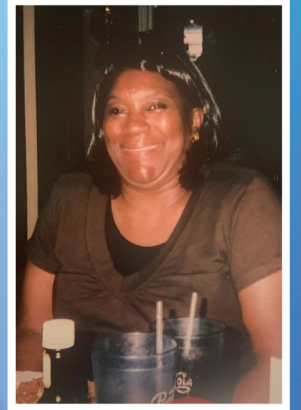

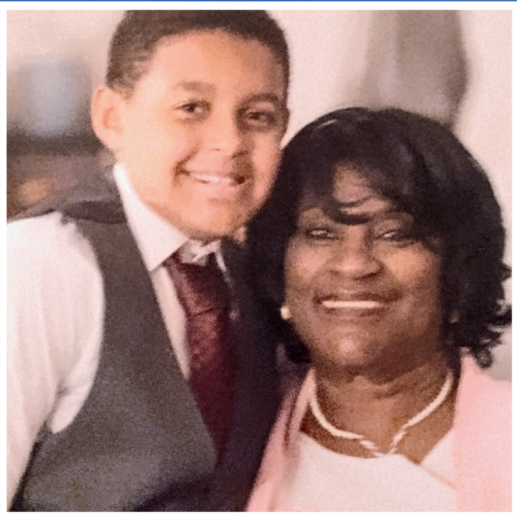
