THE ROLE

The Squash Australia National Coach will be responsible for coaching Australian players at major international events and at the National Training Centre in the daily training environment.

The National Coach will also work closely with the Squash Australia High Performance Manager (HPM) to continuously improve the high performance system in Australia in order to achieve the highest levels of podium success at world class events.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES (WHAT DOES SUCCESS LOOK LIKE)

Provide World Class Coaching for Australian Squash Teams

- Coach at major international events including:
 - Men's and Women's World Team Championships
 - World Doubles Championships
 - Commonwealth Games
 - Other major events (i.e. Youth Olympic Games, Youth Commonwealth Games).
- Monitor the progress of prospective athletes for the above listed events and provide coaching support as is appropriate.
- Contribute to, and be involved with, the selection process for teams for the above listed events in line with Squash Australia's goals and objectives.

Provide World Class Coaching at the National Training Centre

- Create an elite daily training environment at the National Training Centre.
- Provide technical, tactical and other relevant coaching advice for players in the Winning Edge Squad and at the National Training Centre.
- Work collaboratively with the National Training Centre support team to optimise the development of National Training Centre athletes across all areas contributing to squash performance.

Work with the Squash Australia HPM to continuously improve the high performance system in Australia

- Contribute to the selection and development of the National Junior Coaching Team.
- Maintain strong relationships and have regular communication with high performance coaches throughout Australia to lead a high performing culture across the country.
- Provide coaching support at junior camps where appropriate.
- Contribute to the national coach education system.

- Have relevant coaching experience and a proven record of success in both singles and doubles at an international level.
- Ability to work collaboratively and communicate effectively with coaches, athletes, support staff and key stakeholders in Australian squash.
- Capable of working successfully in high pressure circumstances.
