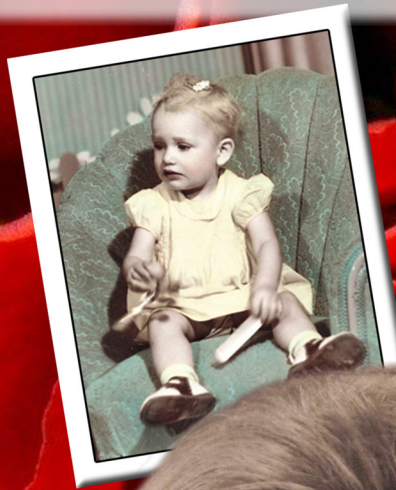

After a few months, the owners decided to move and asked Darlene to take over the management of the newspaper. Thirty-two and a half years later she retired. Darlene served as a volunteer on the Baker City Park Board for 20 years, serving as chairman for 18 of those years. In her tenure on the Park Board, she managed the baseball program, hiring and supervising the coaches. She supervised the employees who maintained the city parks and was responsible for the budget. Darlene also organized Fallon County Days for close to 20 years. In 2020, Darlene was honored as Baker's Citizen of the Year. Darlene was a member of the American Lutheran Church. She enjoyed working in her garden, playing cards especially pinochle and whist, spending time with her grandkids, playing softball, watching sporting events and the game show network.

Darlene is survived by her son, Tim (Katie); daughters, Tammy (Don Bruha) and Julie; grandchildren, Caleb, Andrew, Isabella, Sterling, Kordell, Aliyah; brothers Bill (Joy) Price and Jim
