The NAD Camp Ministries Committee has suggested the following procedures for Camp reports. The Summer Camp Report and the Year-around Camp Report are combined. Only fill out the sections that are relevant to your camp.

Timeframe for 2018 Report – End of Labor Day (Sept. 4) 2017 to End of Labor Day (Sept. 3) 2018

When to report – Deadline for reporting is October 1, 2018. This way results can be presented at NAD Year End Meetings to division, union, and conference administrators and at the AACP Convention.

Where to report – Online option will be available at www.AdventistCamps.org. Hardcopy option can be done by writing totals to the left of each item below. Email to TracyWood@nadAdventist.org

Summer Camp Evangelism Report – include the following:

1. Number of hired summer staff – include academy/high school, college students, and all adults
2. Number of volunteers – include all who assist without compensation regardless of how much time they work
3. Number of summer campers – include Blind Campers and all kids
4. Number of family campers – include all kids and adults
5. Number of summer camp and family camp weeks – include the total number of weeks your hired summer camp staff work to facilitate summer camp. Do not include Camp Meeting
6. Number of individuals who make a decision for Christ – include first-time decisions and recommitments to Christ that are recorded on a decision card for follow-up back home. (Note: each camp should develop their own Decision Card with the information necessary for follow-up contact by a pastor or camp representative.)
7. Number of individuals who request baptism – include baptisms at camp and decisions for baptism that are recorded on a decision card for follow-up back home.

Year-around/Conference Center/Off-season/Additional Groups Report – include the following:

1. Number of Hired Staff – do not include staff hired only for summer camp
2. Volunteer Staff – include all who assist without compensation regardless of how much time they work. Do not include those that volunteer only for summer camp
3. Number of Adventist Church Groups – include all groups from an Adventist church
4. Number of Sessions of Outdoor School – include groups sponsored by Education dept.
5. Number of Conference-sponsored Events – include groups sponsored by Conf dept's
6. Number of Non-Adventist User Groups – include all groups that are not Adventist
7. Camp Meetings – include conference camp meeting if hosted at camp
8. Total User Groups – total number of groups for the year, do not include summer camps
9. Total Guests – total number of guests that stayed at camp for all groups excluding summer camp
10. Total Camper Days – total number of days each guest stayed at camp excluding summer camp
