She attended Snow College and graduated from Brigham Young University with a bachelor's degree in elementary education. She married C. Paul Ogden immediately upon his return from his mission to Mexico.

Carolyn was a school teacher in the Provo City School District and Ogden City School District. She specialized in Kindergarten-Third grade. She shared her love of music with the students she taught and organized children's choirs wherever she went.

Carolyn served in many capacities in The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. She served with her husband as an ordinance worker in the Manti temple for 15 years. They were called to serve a 6 month temple mission to the Nauvoo Temple. Carolyn and Paul later served as CES Literacy Missionaries for 18 months in the Richfield Utah Stake and they served as Family History Consultants and Facilitators for the Self Reliance program.

Carolyn was a devoted BYU Cougars sports fan. She was also an avid Coach Andy Reid football fan.
