in Cascade Park (just a few blocks south of Mill Plain).

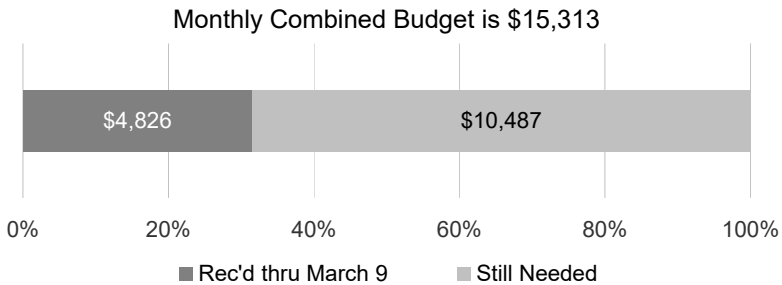
