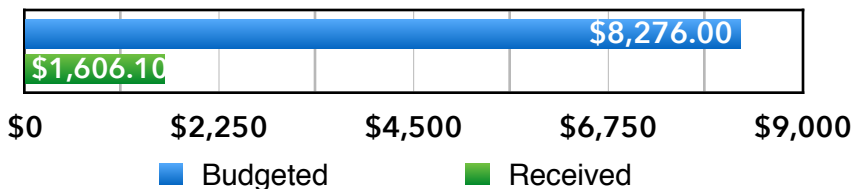
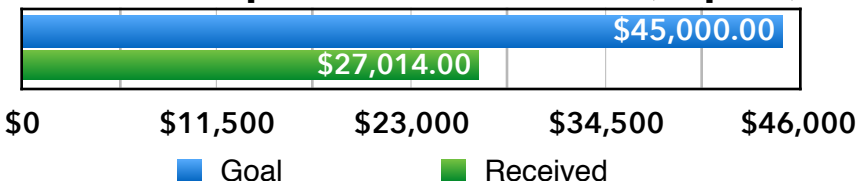

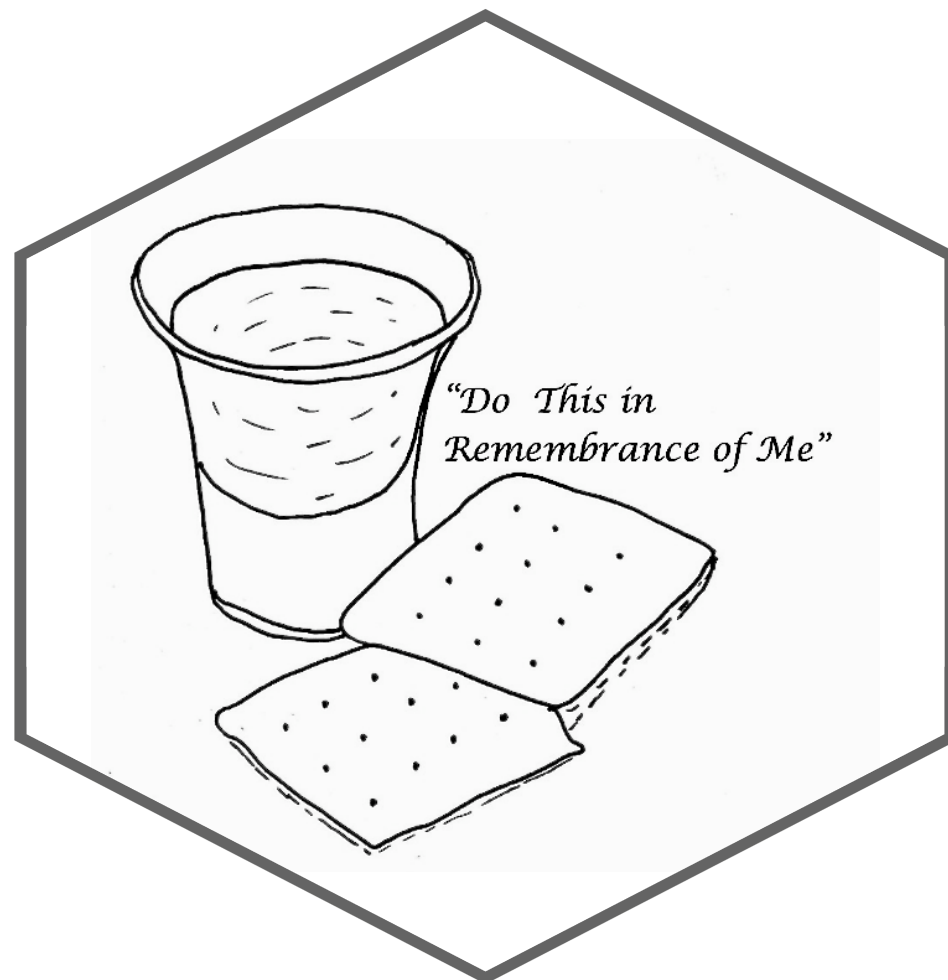

Our church extends the invitation to everyone present, regardless of church membership, to participate in the Communion Service, today during the Worship Service.

Prior to partaking of the bread and the juice as symbols of Christ's body and blood, broken and shed on the Cross of Calvary, it is the practice of our church to follow Christ's example by participating in the Service of Footwashing based on John 13.
