Rev. Alan writes... Advent Week 4 saw a wonderful array of activities as we continue our journey towards Christmas. The Lighthouse takeover nativity at St. Peter's was fabulous with some outstanding performances from the children. The children from Johnson Fold Primary did themselves and their school proud singing beautifully at St. Andrew's carol service. And the Nine Lessons and Carols raised the roof at St. Peter's last Sunday evening! Thanks and well done to everyone involved in these and a whole host of events across the week. I'm so proud of you all.

Looking ahead to Christmas Eve - the final Sunday in Advent - we have a focus on Peace in the morning services as we light the fourth Advent candle known as the "Angel's Candle", to remind us of the angels' message: "Peace on Earth, Good Will Toward Humankind". 
