

Am I Eligible To Apply For The LSRF Award?

START

I received my PhD/MD within the last 5 years (on or after Oct 1, 2016)
OR
 I will receive my PhD/MD between Oct 1, 2021 and August 1, 2022

What about my visa?
 The U.S. institution where you will carry out your postdoc research is responsible for your work visa and will determine which type of visa is needed. If selected for funding you must have your visa by the time the award is activated on August 1, 2022 and maintain legal working status for the duration of the award.

All complete applications received through our online application portal will be reviewed by our peer review committee. A complete application means that an applicant has completed and finalized their submission by 8:00pm EST on October 1, 2021 AND that the required three (3) reference letters and one (1) supervisor letter were received by 8:00pm EST on November 1, 2021. Incomplete applications will not be considered and there will not be any deadline extensions.
