He was, at times, wisdom for some and conviction for others.

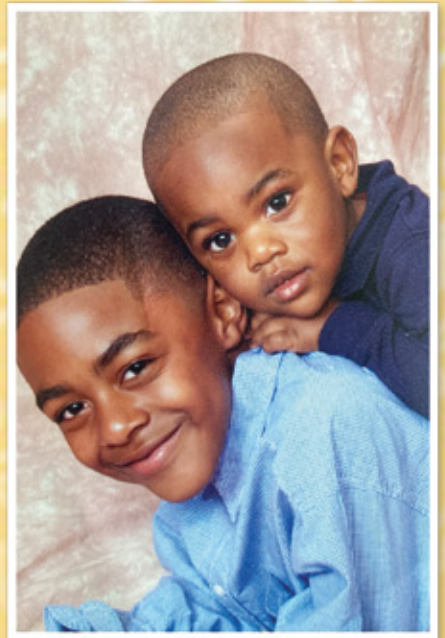
He was a friend, a brother, a son, a husband, and a father.

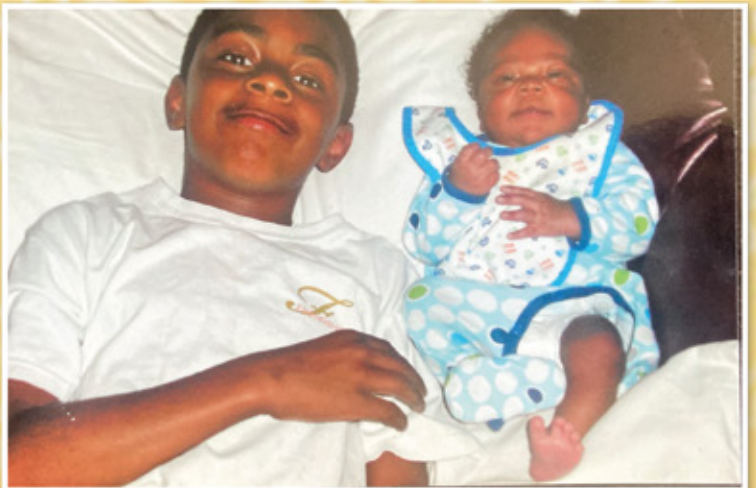
