On the table outside the secretary's office, at the end of the fish aquariums there is a large black pot with a ruler in the dirt. Growing in the dirt is a sprouted potato that was used for an experiment in Mrs. Kaiser's science class. Rather than throwing out the potato, we decided to put it in a pot and see what happened. The end of the aquarium is an ideal environment since there are grow lights supporting the hydroponics seedlings there. On Thursday morning the plant measured 6 cm tall, and by early afternoon it had grown to 7 cm. Mrs. Kaiser put the ruler in the pot because it was obvious that the plant was growing like crazy and she wanted some objective measure rather than just a "guess-timate."
