WHEN I'M GONE

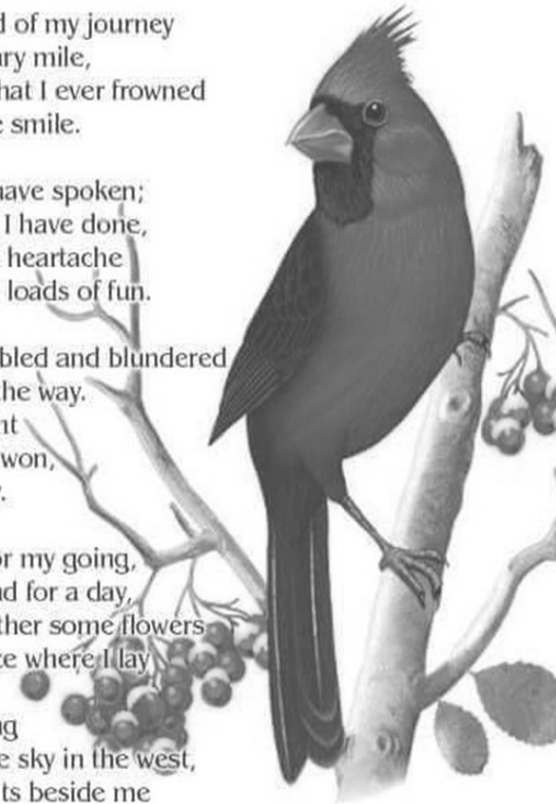
When I come to the end of my journey
