Pastor's Note

OPERATION SECOND LOOK

Former president George H.W. Bush was a Navy pilot during World War II. On one mission, after being hit by Japanese gunfire, he had to bail out of his burning torpedo bomber. That did not go smoothly. As he bailed, he slammed his head against part of the plane, cutting and bruising himself badly, and partially tearing his parachute. He plummeted swiftly to the earth and might have been killed if he had not landed in the ocean.

Mr. Bush received a Distinguished Flying Cross for his troubles, but before he left the Navy he promised himself he would jump out of an airplane again someday and this time get it right.

It took five decades and a stint as president of the United States before he got around to it, but on March 25, 1997, George H.W. Bush, age seventy-two, jumped from a plane at 12,500 feet above an army testing base in the desert of Arizona. With him were several jumpers from the Parachute Industry Association and the Army's Golden Knights demonstration team. The former president and his "shepherds" sailed without a hitch to the ground, and Bush made a feather-soft landing just forty yards from the target X.

"It was wonderful," he told onlookers enthusiastically. "I'm a new man. I go home exhilarated."

It took fifty years, but in what had been termed Operation Second Look George H.W. Bush had closed the book on a bad memory. *(From Craig Brian Larson and Leadership Journal)*
