I am the swift uplifting rush

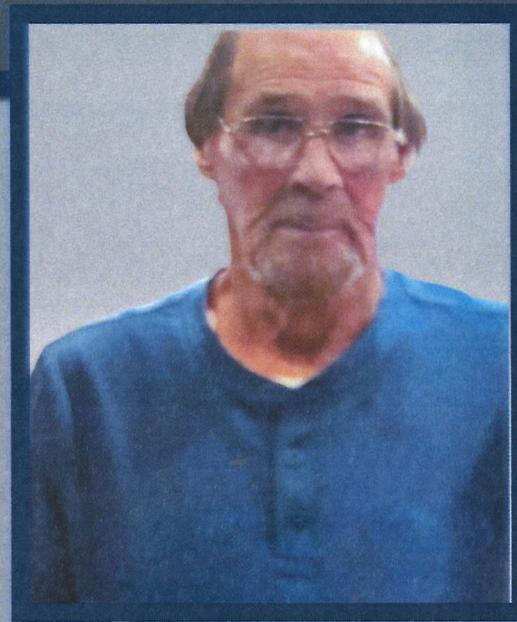
Of quiet bird in circled flight.
