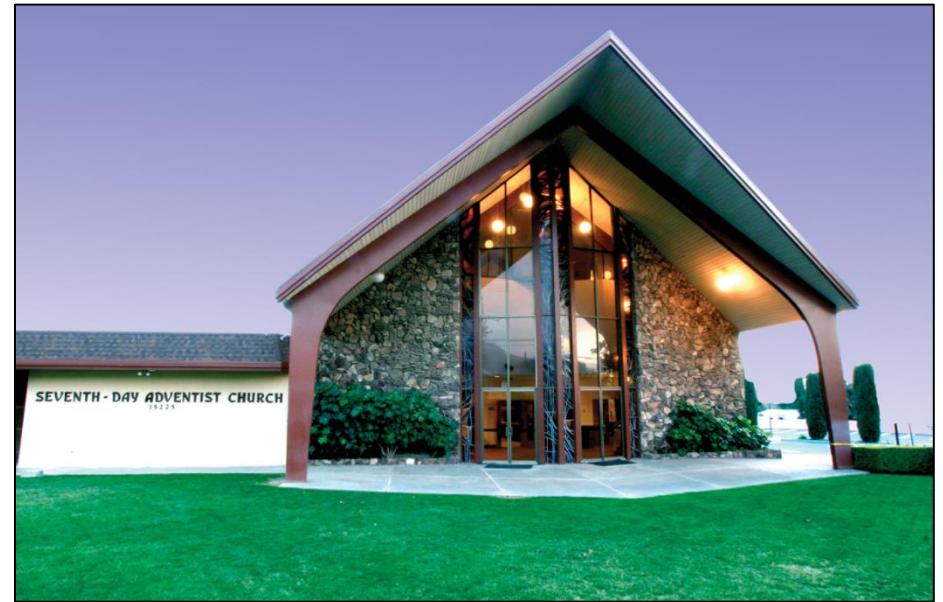

2. **MEMORIAL OF JUNE BOBST:** will be this Sabbath afternoon, **January 26**, at **2 pm** in the Sanctuary.

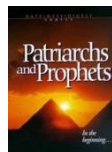
3. **VESPERS** this evening at **4 pm** will start our series on the Sanctuary. Pastor Cliff Lim will present “The Laver & the Water of Life”.

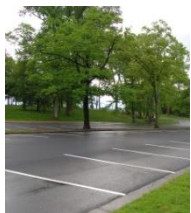

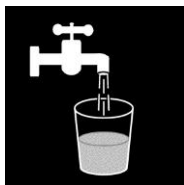
