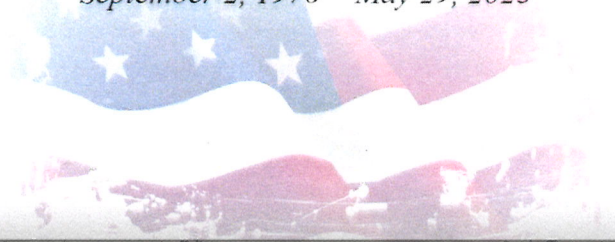




*In Loving Memory*
