She was baptized February 11, 1923 at Friedenstal Lutheran Church by Rev. George Zink. She was confirmed June 19, 1938 at Zion Lutheran Church by Rev. George Zink. Her Bible verse was Psalm 121: 7-8. Martha was united in marriage to Emil Ziegler, January 26, 1947 at Scotland, SD. They farmed and raised their four children 5½ miles east of Tripp. Martha and Emil retired and moved into Tripp in February 1983. Martha loved her family, sewing, quilting, baking, gardening, and canning. Her grandchildren always knew there were cookies or bars in the freezer when they came to visit. She loved to play games with them like jacks (which she was great at), find the button and they all learned how to jump rope in her basement. Martha passed away Saturday, July 22, 2023 at Menno-Olivet Care Center at the age of 100.
