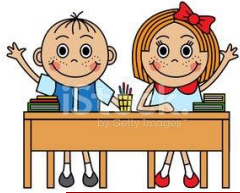

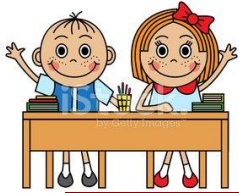
Reading Logs are due every Friday. Please turn them in on Monday if you need the weekend to complete the 75 minutes of reading time with your child this week!

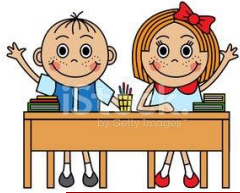
