

### Lynne Lorraine Brown 1943 - 2024

Lynne Lorraine Brown, 81, of Provo Utah passed away in her home on July 25, 2024. She was born on June 1,1943 to Kenneth Austin Lauritzen and Florence Manon Bayha Lauritzen in Grangeville Idaho.
