Lynne Lorraine Brown, 81, of Provo Utah passed away in her home on July 25, 2024. She was born on June 1, 1943 to Kenneth Austin Lauritzen and Florence Manon Bayha Lauritzen in Grangeville Idaho. She married Kenneth Robert Brown on June 4, 1965 and they were sealed in the Provo Utah Temple on November 28, 1975.

Lynne lived with her parents and her four brothers in several towns in Idaho, Utah, and in the territory of Alaska until the family finally settled in Springville Utah where she graduated high school in 1961.
