5. Daily Topics

- a. **Day 1 (Wed, Jan 6)** – Jesus’ Most Precious Gift
Key Text – “How much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!” (Luke 11:13).
Prayer Focus: The Holy Spirit
- b. **Day 2 (Thurs, Jan 7)** – Grasping the Gift
“How wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ” (Ephesians 3:18).
Prayer Focus: Seeing, Believing and Receiving God’s Love for Us
- c. **Day 3 (Fri, Jan 8)** – Surrender is the Key
“Offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God – this is your true and proper worship” (Romans 12:1).
Prayer Focus: Complete Surrender in Every Area / ANNOINTING SERVICE

Anointing Service Purpose

This anointing service is for the whole church. Often it is thought that anointing is only for people on their death beds, but this is not the case. Anointing is for many things. Healing from physical disease, cancer, an injury, appetite or other physical challenges. Healing from emotional challenges like bitterness, unforgiveness, resentment, anger, anxiety, depression, broken marital relations, broken family relations etc. Healing from spiritual challenges like lack of faith, hardness of heart, rebellion, spiritual oppression or darkness, apathy, lack of faithfulness in finances, difficulty reading the Bible or praying, lack of spiritual desire etc.

- d. **Day 4 (Sab, Jan 9)** – Putting Revival into Practice
“Yet you do not have because you do not ask. You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures” (James 4:2-3).
Prayer Focus: Accepting and Experiencing True Revival
- e. **Day 5 (Sun, Jan 10)** – Spiritual or Carnal: What’s the Difference?
“But we have the mind of Christ” (1 Corinthians 2:16)
Prayer Focus: Moving from Natural or Carnal to a Spiritual Christian
- f. **Day 6 (Mon, Jan 11)** – God’s Solution to Our Struggle
“If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it” (Luke 9:23-24).
Prayer Focus: The Importance of Daily Asking, Receiving and Surrendering to God
- g. **Day 7 (Tues, Jan 12)** – Praying God’s Promises
“Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you” (Matthew 7:7).
Prayer Focus: Claiming God’s Promises Through His Word
- h. **Day 8 (Wed, Jan 13)** – Obedience Through Jesus
“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new” (2 Corinthians 5:17).
Prayer Focus: Obedience Through Prayer and Faith in God’s Work in Us
- i. **Day 9 (Thurs, Jan 14)** – Do I Work for God – Or Does He Work Through Me?
“I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me” (Galatians 2:20).
Prayer Focus: God’s Continued Work in Us Through His Spirit
- j. **Day 10 (Fri, Jan 15)** – Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,’ says the Lord of hosts” (Zechariah 4:6).
Prayer Focus: A Continual Walk with the Spirit
