Mother also loved spending time with her family. She really enjoyed going to Olive Garden, and she would ALWAYS order the Zupa Toscana, and not to mention she loved drinking her Coca Colas.

She became a Mother, a Grandmother, a Great-Grandmother, and even a Great Grandmother over the course of her Eighty-Nine years here. She would often be the main babysitter, and she took pride in her role as the matriarch of the family.
