Upon graduation, she moved to Parkland, Washington, where she attended Pacific Lutheran University; attaining a Bachelors of Arts Degree. In 1987, she moved back to Minnesota and worked at Sears, Fleet Farm, and then T.J.Maxx in St Cloud as the Operations Manager. In October of 2022, Jan was diagnosed with cancer, two weeks before her retirement.
