Reservations are on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications MUST have a deposit of \$30.00 for tents or \$40.00 for RV space w/electric/water. DEPOSITS MUST BE MADE BY THE END OF THIS YEAR'S CAMP MEETING SESSION TO GUARANTEE SITE AND ARE **NOT REFUNDABLE** AFTER MARCH 1, 2020. **Full payments for tent spots should be made by May 1, 2020.**

An adult is required to stay in each tent or trailer.

Private tents in Section E are now on a reservation basis. Those registered on a site have priority for next year. All other regulations will apply. On sites for private tent or trailer, only one family unit permitted per site. Private tents or RVs may be set up between the hours of 8:00am and 6:00 pm starting Thursday of the week camp meeting begins, however, **NO OCCUPANCY BEFORE FRIDAY.**

*Senior citizen discount of ten percent (10%) will be given upon request with this application for those 60 years and above.
