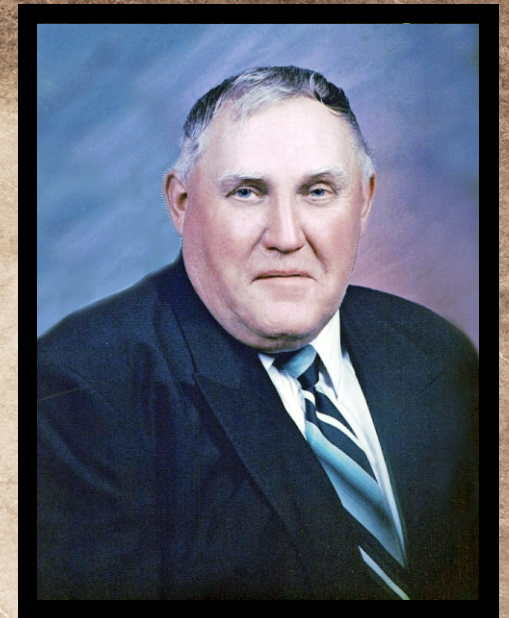

Lloyd Clarence Erickson, 79, of Roxbury, KS, peacefully passed away on Wednesday, June 5, 2024, at Angel Arms, McPherson. He was a retired farmer and also deputy sheriff for the McPherson County Sheriff's Department.
