and mercy shall follow me all the

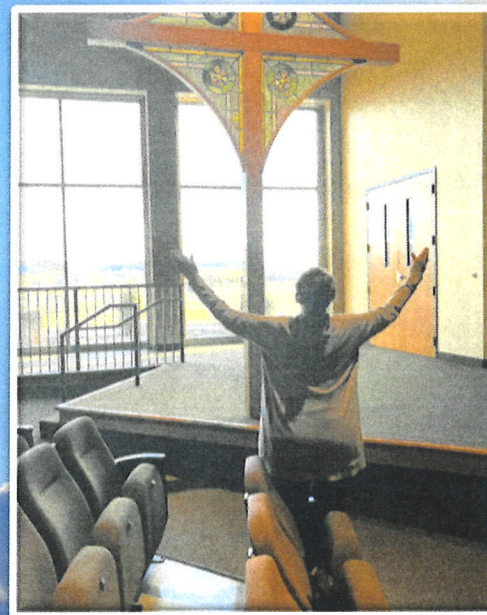
days of my life; and I will dwell in the
