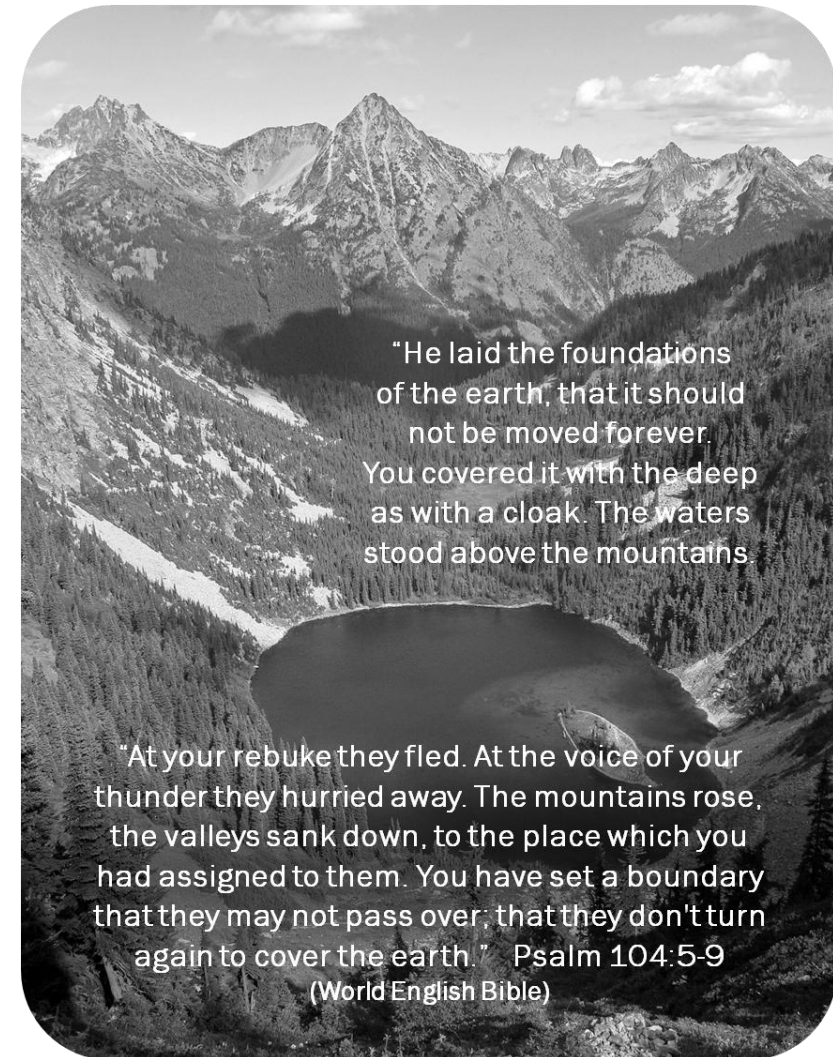

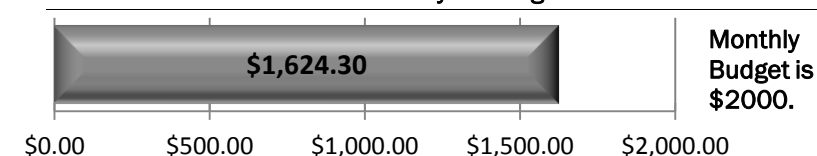
Announcements
