Connie Neigum, age 66, Bismarck ND, died June 8th at Sanford Medical Center after a year-long courageous fight with cancer.

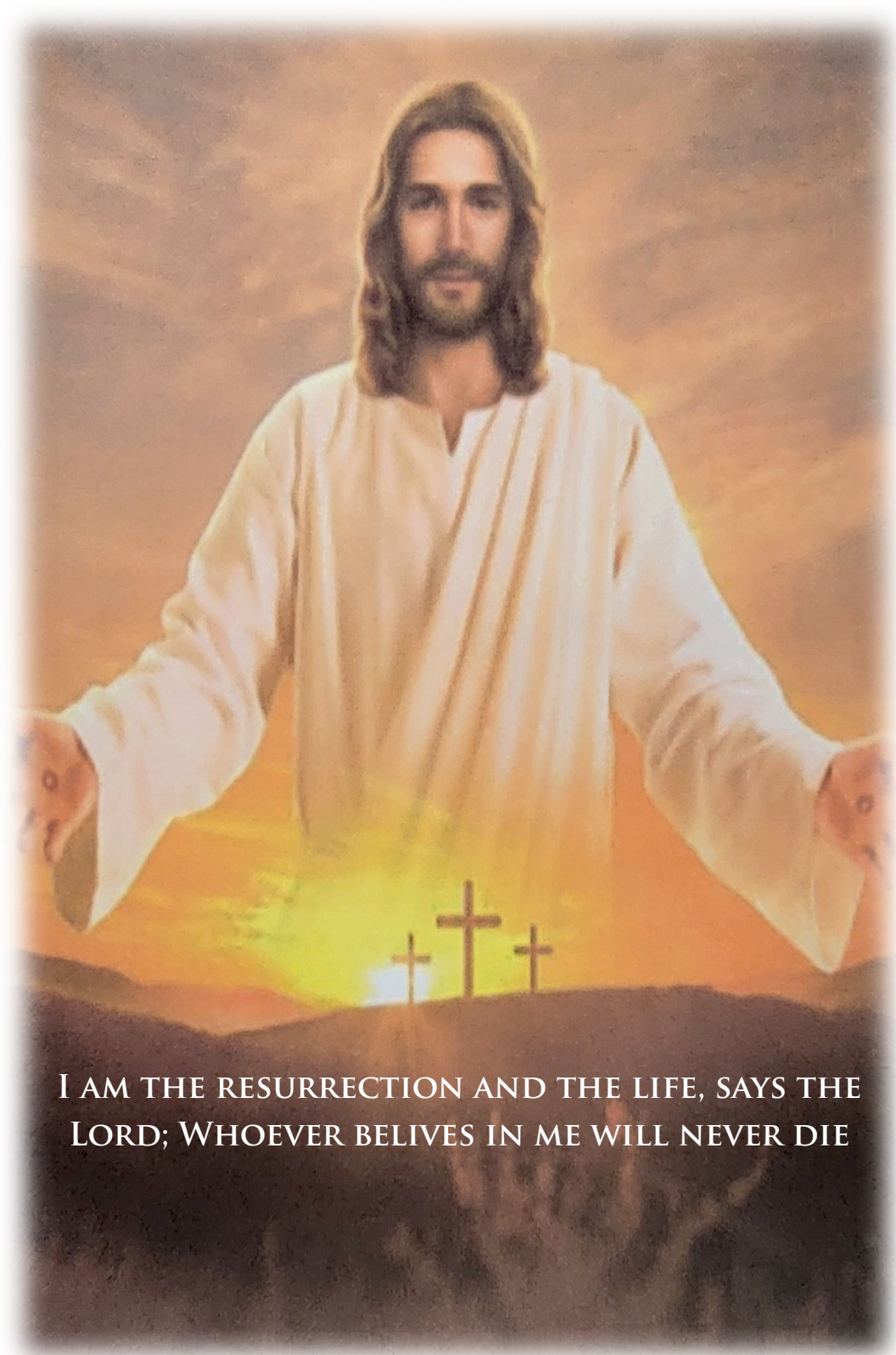

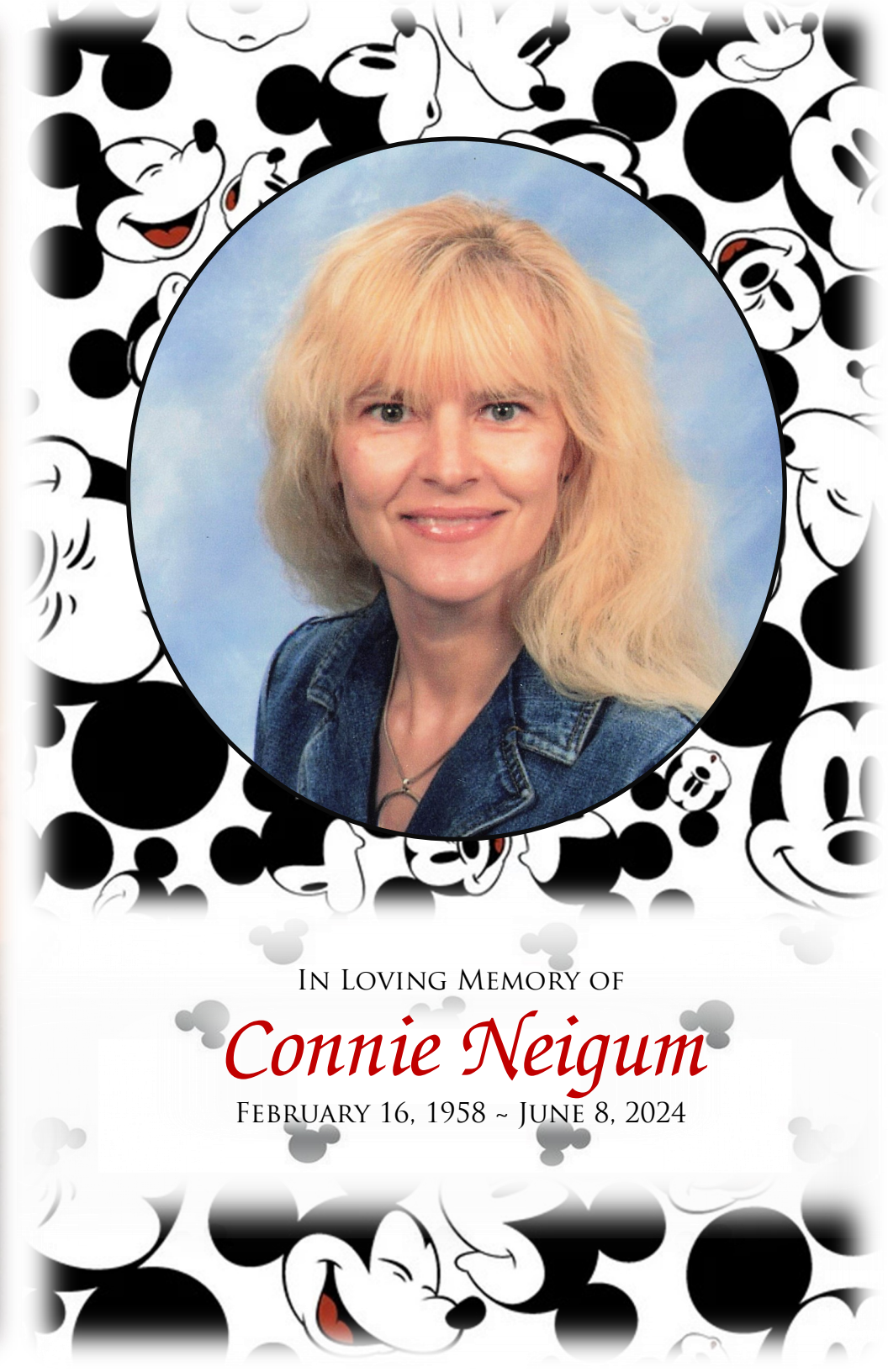
