Lights the dark corners of my heart.

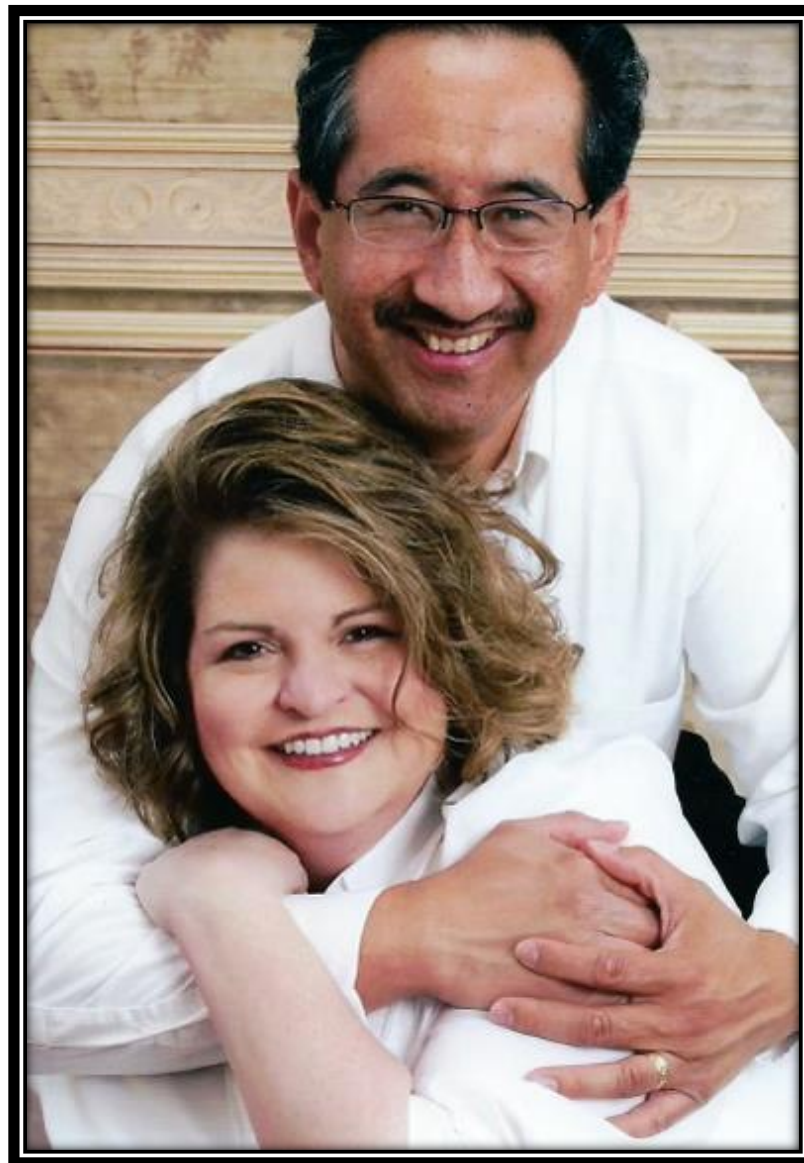
Her father calls her chatterbox

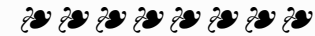
