**Bible/Art** – Make a heart display to conclude our “God’s Magnetic Love” unit:

**MATERIALS NEEDED:** • cardboard or paper • markers • colored crepe paper optional • red paper or paint optional

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Cut a giant heart shape out of cardboard (or paper if you don’t have cardboard)
2. Paint the heart red or cover it in red paper if you have it. You could pleat a crepe paper fringe in a contrasting color around the edge of the heart or make a colored design around it for added detail.
3. Neatly write the following verses found in 1 Corinthians 13:4-8a on the heart.  
Love is patient and kind.  
Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude.  
Love does not demand its own way.  
Love is not irritable, and it keeps no record of when it has been wronged.  
Love is never glad about injustice.  
Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful,  
Love endures through every circumstance.  
Love never fails.
4. Bring your heart display to school when we are back in classes. They will be put up in the hall.

**Math** – Bring math assignments back to school when we are back in classes.

4<sup>th</sup> grade: Write and solve 15 division problems on a piece of paper. The problems should have three digit dividends and single digit divisors. Show all work on the paper. Write very neatly and remember to keep place values lined up. An example problem:  $4 \overline{)752}$

3<sup>rd</sup> grade: Write and solve 15 subtraction problems on a piece of paper. The problems should have three digit minuends and subtrahends. Show all work on the paper. Write very neatly and remember to keep place values lined up. An example problem:  $568$
