

DBC Lent Readings WEEK 6 – 1 CORINTHIANS 15 – POWER OF THE RESURRECTION

We move on from people who saw the risen Jesus, to some of the impacts Jesus Resurrection has made, as we read through 1 Corinthians 15. Each day we will focus on one aspect and its impact on our lives by “Living through the lens of the Resurrection” ... how does it encourage us, as the last verse encourages says, to “stand firm” and “give ourselves fully to the work of the Lord.”

26 Mar – Read 1 CORINTHIANS 15 - Reflect on today’s sermon

27 Mar – 1 COR 15v3-8 + v 58 – [v3+4] “Christ died ...was buried .. raised from the dead ...”

QU Why were all three steps so important for Jesus to do, to solve the “problem of sin”?

QU [V58] How does knowing this equip us to “stand firm”, and in our “work of the Lord”?

28 Mar – 1 COR 15v12-20 + v58 – [v20] “Christ .. has been raised from the dead”

QU Why is the fact that Jesus rose from the dead so fundamental to how we view this life and the life to come?

QU [V58] How does knowing this equip us to “stand firm”, and in our “work of the Lord”?

29 Mar - 1 COR 15v20-28 + v58 – [v26] “the last enemy to be destroyed is death”

QU Where did “death” come from? ... Why did it need to be destroyed?

QU [V58] How does knowing this equip us to “stand firm”, and in our “work of the Lord”?

30 Mar - 1 COR 15 v35-49 + v58 - [v42-44] New body “ imperishable .. glory . power .. spiritual ..”

QU Are you looking forward to having a new body? ... why will you need it?

QU [V58] How does knowing this equip us to “stand firm”, and in our “work of the Lord”?

31 Mar –1 COR 15v50-54 + v58 – [v52] “in a flash ... twinkling of an eye ... at the last trumpet.”

QU Do you live in expectation and hope for this sudden change?. .. How should we wait for it?

QU [V58] How does knowing this equip us to “stand firm”, and in our “work of the Lord”?

1 Apr – 1 COR 15v54-58 – [v57] “.. thank God! He gives us victory over sin & death through .. our Lord Jesus Christ.”

QU How big an enemy is “death” to sinners? ... Is it still any enemy to all who believe in Jesus?

QU [V58] How does knowing this equip us to “stand firm”, and in our “work of the Lord”?
