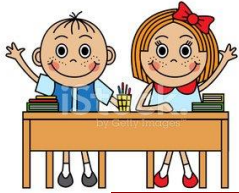

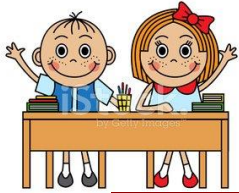
### Reading Logs are due every Friday.
